Muuga Harbour Industrial Park

- Total area of 76 ha with detailed planning, and all utilities connected up to the plot borders.
- The only port in the Baltics with direct access to Rail Baltica, featuring a freight terminal inside the port.
- Free Zone: simplified customs procedures, no import/export taxes, and unlimited storage time.

THE PORT:

Muuga Harbour is the largest and deepest cargo port in Estonia, covering 567 ha. The harbor services containers, liquid bulk, dry bulk, general cargo, and ro-ro traffic. Its industrial park will feature Rail Baltica's multimodal terminal inside the port, enabling goods to be seamlessly transhipped between different modes of transport.

Paldiski South Harbour Industrial Park

- Total area of 39 ha, with detailed planning and significant potential for future projects.
- Future offshore wind and alternative energy hub.

THE PORT:

Paldiski South Harbour is a multi-functional port with the shortest route to Sweden, covering 119 ha. The harbor handles ro-ro, general cargo, and both dry and liquid bulk.
